

Where Can You Find Fenn's Treasure?

Are you looking for Fenn's Treasure? Then it's a good thing to know where to look and the places you might find it. Forrest Fenn narrowed the search area down for his treasure chest to the following areas:

- Fenn's treasure is hidden in the mountains somewhere north of Santa Fe (*The Thrill of the Chase* book, page 131)
- Fenn's treasure is located within the geographical region of the Rocky Mountains (*Too Far Too Walk* book, map on page 265)
- Fenn's treasure can be found within the boundaries of one of the following states: New Mexico, Colorado, Wyoming, and Montana (*Too Far Too Walk* book, map on page 265)
- Fenn's treasure is located more than 66,000 links north of Santa Fe, New Mexico (equals about 8.243 miles) (April 16, 2012 [Blog comment #136 from Forrest](#))

Other Area Qualifiers:

- Fenn's treasure is hidden higher than 5,000 feet above sea level (Feb 28, 2013 [Today Show Interview at 00:53](#))
- Fenn's treasure is hidden below 10,200 feet elevation above sea level (Today Show Interview)
- Fenn's treasure is hidden within the highlighted area on the map in his *Too Far To Walk* book ([see the map below](#))

Other Location Qualifiers:

- The "where warm waters halt" clue is not related to a dam (May 16, 2015 [Scrapbook Sixty Eight](#))
- Fenn's treasure is not buried in an out house (May 29, 2015 [Radio Interview on YouTube](#))
- He didn't say he "buried it", he said he "hid it" (March 26, 2013 [Radio Interview on YouTube](#))
- Fenn's treasure is not in a mine (Interview)
- Fenn's treasure is not in a graveyard (May 3, 2013 [Today Show Interview at 02:10](#))
- Fenn's treasure is not associated with any structure (March 27, 2013 [Today Show Interview at 02:29](#))
- You can find Fenn's treasure without a flashlight during the day (June 30, 2014 [Questions With Forrest Fenn](#))
